Leesa Richards grew up in Detroit where she experienced its music-rich culture. From this exposure, she showed an inclination towards the arts at a very early age. However, when she saw the Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater, this sparked her interest and she knew she wanted to be a professional dancer. She attended the University of North Carolina School of the Arts and obtained a degree in dance.

Leesa performing arts career started with a variety of dance companies. She was selected to perform the role of Mary Magdalene in the national tour of the Broadway musical, Jesus Christ Superstar. She earned critical acclaim and led to featured performances in several musical productions throughout the U.S. and Europe.
